

## ANNOUNCING DR. JAMES CALLEROZ WHITE, OUR NEXT HEAD OF SCHOOL



The Dwight-Englewood Board of Trustees is thrilled to announce that they have unanimously selected Dr. James Calleroz White as Dwight-Englewood's 7th Head of School, beginning his tenure on July 1, 2025. Amidst an intensive and competitive international search that uncovered numerous highly skilled and talented educators, Dr. Calleroz White clearly emerged as the leader most uniquely suited to guide our school into a bright new chapter filled with promise, excellence, collaboration and compassion.

Dr. Calleroz White, who holds a Doctorate in Educational Leadership from Arizona State University, a Master's in Education from Harvard Graduate School of Education, and a Bachelor's degree from Harvard University, brings to D-E a distinguished record of accomplishments and an impressive background in independent school leadership, innovation, and student-focused community building.

Currently serving as Head of School at The Galloway School in Atlanta, Dr. Calleroz White has overseen transformative projects, including the design and construction of a new upper school building, expanding the school's experiential learning and entrepreneurial programs to make use of the City of Atlanta as a classroom, and creating the Center for Professional Growth and Learning for all teaching and learning and professional development across the school.

Dr. Calleroz White loves to stay engaged in the lives of students and has served as the primary college counselor for several students each year, and, when his schedule allows, he enjoys teaching classes in government, ethics and entrepreneurship. Throughout his career, he has emphasized educational excellence, strategic growth, and, above all, fostering meaningful connections between students, educators and communities.

Before his time at Galloway, Dr. Calleroz White served as Head of School at Louisville Collegiate School, as Associate Head of School at Phoenix Country Day School, and as Director of College Counseling at Belmont Hill School in Belmont, MA. He began his career in education as a Harvard College Admissions Officer, where he recruited students from New Jersey. He has held numerous positions of leadership in organizations across the educational landscape, including as a current Trustee for the National Association of Independent Schools (NAIS) in Washington, DC.
